



SUMMER JACKPOT RULES

300 Game Jackpot Rules

- All bowlers automatically entered via their entry fee of which \$2 goes to the jackpot
- To win the scratch 300 game jackpot a bowler must roll 12 consecutive strikes in one game during qualifying (does not include finals)
- To win the handicap 300 game jackpot a bowler must bowl a 300 game or higher when adding their per game handicap to their scratch score during qualifying (does not include finals)
- For a 210 & under bowler to win the 300 game jackpot they must have established a tournament average with a minimum of 9 games
- If more than one bowler in a tournament rolls a 300 game or higher the jackpot is split
- The amount of the jackpot is determined prior to the event which means the money collected at the current event will be used for the next tournament's jackpot
- The LIGBT will start both jackpots by adding \$300 to each

Mystery Game Jackpot Rules

- All bowlers automatically entered via their entry fee of which \$2 goes to the jackpot
- There is one jackpot for both the scratch and handicap bowler (this allows the amount of the pot to grow faster!)
- During each event an LIGBT bowler will pick a random number out of a hat between 125 & 300 and that becomes the mystery number. If a scratch bowler's 3rd game matches that number or if a 210 & under bowler matches that number in their 2nd game of qualifying they win the posted jackpot amount.
- If more than one bowler matches the number the jackpot is split
- The jackpot amount is determined prior to the event which means the money collected at the current event will be used for the next tournament's jackpot
- The LIGBT will start the jackpot by adding \$300
