THE ULTIMATE DOUBLES RULES & FORMAT (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

Welcome to LGBT doubles tournaments. Our Ultimate Handicap Doubles events are a fun competition with significant prize money. Last season the LGBT averaged an incredible 117 teams per doubles tournament. All doubles competitions offer an optional singles event featuring a \$20 entry fee, 1 in 4 prize list, and a \$300 top prize with 50 entries.

What makes our doubles events so special is you can partner with as many bowlers as you like and cash with every team you are on. Entry fees are just \$80 per bowler for your original team and \$40 per bowler for your extra teams.

ENTRY FEE: Your original 2-person team entry fee is \$160 or \$80 per bowler. \$80 Entry Fee Breakdown: \$20 lineage/\$10 expenses/\$50 prize money - 100% returned. \$40 Entry Fee Breakdown: \$0 lineage/\$5 expenses/\$35 prize money - 100% returned. Any additional doubles teams you want to form the entry fee is reduced to \$80 or \$40 per bowler. NOTE: All extra doubles teams created must be done on-site and cannot pre-register. All entries paid with a credit/debit card will incur a \$3 per bowler convenience fee.

HOW TO PAY: We offer several options to pay the team entry (individual entry fees not accepted on-line): 1. Go to www.ligbtour.com and enter on-line. 2. Pay with Zelle (516.637.5955) (no fees) 3. Pay by Venmo (@ligbt) (no fees). You can also pay on-site with cash or credit/debit card. A \$3 per bowler convenience fee will be added for all entries paying with a credit/debit card.

WALK-INS: Walk-in entries are welcomed. Both team and singles can sign up at the host center the day of the tournament. There is no extra fee required for walk-in entries. PLEASE ARRIVE TO THE HOST CENTER AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SQUAD.

SINGLES: Don't have a partner...no problem! All single bowlers looking for a partner should come down to the host center at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the tournament. We will happily match you up with another bowler. There are always bowlers looking to team up!

REFUNDS: Anyone prepaying and does not bowl will be entitled to a full refund (minus credit card fees) as long as the tournament director is notified prior to the start of the tournament. Once a bowler starts scoring no refunds will be issued for any reason.

ELIGIBILITY: This is an amateur only event. Exceptions to the "NO PBA RULE" are made if the competitive balance is not affected. Youth bowlers may jeopardize their amateur status if they bowl in a doubles event.

AVERAGE/HANDICAP: LGBT bowlers will use their latest modified house shot average. Non-members will have their average determined by using their highest 2-year composite average minus 10 pins. All individual handicaps are based on 90% of 230. Bowlers without an average listed on BOWL.com must provide proof of average (league sheet) or must bowl scratch. The doubles team handicap is the sum of the two individual handicaps. The LGBT reserves the right to re-rate any bowler if their average doesn't represent their true ability. Bonus pins are not used in doubles events. Please note the maximum handicap permitted for men is 72 pins (150 average) and 81 pins for women (140 average.) Please note: Games bowled in doubles events will count when determining your LGBT average in future modified house shot tournaments.

TEAM MAKE-UP: Teams will consist of any 2 amateur bowlers but cannot exceed a team maximum of 460. When determining the maximum, you use a non-LGBT bowler's highest composite average the past 2 years minus 10 pins, and LGBT bowler's latest modified house shot average listed on our website.

EXTRA TEAMS: All bowlers that have an original partner can team up with any other bowler that also has an original partner (\$40 per bowler/\$80 per extra team.) The team maximum (460) applies to all extra teams. Bowlers may cash with an unlimited number of teams. Both bowlers on extra teams must consent to teaming up.

FORMAT: All teams bowl 4-games, on a modified house shot, across 8 lanes. The 4-game team handicap total determines final prize fund position. There is no final.

GUARANTEES: The winning doubles team earns \$2,000 with 80+ total teams. When determining the number of teams cashing you divide the total number of teams by 6 (1 in 6.) Minimum prize for a cashing team is \$160.

ADDITIONAL RULES: USBC rules apply when not covered by LGBT rules which are posted on LIGBTOUR.com. All bowling balls will be permitted at this competition including urethane. Tournament directors will have final say on all rule decisions.

CODE OF CONDUCT: All entrants are required to act "professionally" when competing in LGBT events. Offensive language and apparel are not allowed and can be a cause for suspension from future tournaments. Anyone that is not "sober" will be requested to leave the bowling center. Any LGBT member speaking negatively about the LGBT on any social media platform will be barred for life from future LGBT events.

LANE CONDITIONS: Lanes will be oiled with a modified house shot prior to the squad. The LGBT posts the pattern at the host site and announces the shot on LIGBTour.com prior to the event.
